# Town Project Updates

KUDOS to the Mesa County Community Center Committee for putting on an awesome 1st De Beque Friendsgiving.It was a great success.

The Town will reevaluate which direction they will be going to remove the debris pile on the Riverfront to the Mesa County Landfill .This will be addressed again in the Spring to either do it in house or put it out to bid again.

The Broadband project is still in the works. The Town continues to meet with the project managers and are continually working on it with several different entities.

The new UV water plant project is at the permitting stage with the state of Colorado. Please attend the Dec. 12th BOT Mtg when the Board discusses the location of the water salesman/distribution

site. With that, we welcome and encourage the public to attend the monthly BOT Mtgs the 4th Tuesday of the month and 6 p.m. and the P & Z meetings which are held on the 2nd Tuesday every month @ 6 p.m. The Commissioners go over action items and also reviews sections of the current Municipal Code for possible revisions and updates.

The Town of De Beque will be hosting the Regional AGNC conference next September in the Mesa County Community Center. AV equipment will be needed for this conference. 

# DE BEQUE INITIATIVE/VOTING

On November 4th the Towns ballet issue/measure passed regarding the consolidation of Town of De Beque Municipal Elections with Mesa County General Election. This measure will coordinate our local election with Mesa County general election. This will assure that election officials who are skilled and trained in election procedure manage

local elections. It will also encourage broader voter turnout and engagement in municipal elections.

What does this mean for residents? Moving forward your elections will be consolidate with the State and Mesa County. It will be moved from April to November with the use of one ballot. Cost savings for printing & staffing. No

duplication processes but De Beque will continue to vote on State, County and Town matters. Better voter turnout. Fewer state regulations required of the Town's designated election official. We will have use of County equipment and staff.

Remaining the same is that outside of De Beque cannot vote on De Beque matters.

# SIDEWALK PROJECT UPDATE

MA Concrete Construction Inc. was recently purchased by Sunrock, so you may see name change in the construction equipment around the jobsite. The project is on schedule and on budget. The current construction cost is estimated at \$622,556 which included \$22,561.68 of additional work

which was to address several water line valave and pipe repairs in the project work area which were not anticipated: and to also address costs with unsuitable subgrade soils along 4th street and also in the alley on 3rd street. The concrete project is anticipated to be completed December

6th and the asphalt patch and paving work are scheduled to occure the week of December 9th. Final clean up work is scheduled to be completed on or before December 17th, 2024. With exception of the water line valve challenges, the project is going very well.

# Recipe of the Month/Creamy Garlic Mushroom Pasta

14 oz Mushrooms sliced 1-2 Onions depending on size and preference 2 tbsp Fresh Thyme/or 1t. dried Salt and pepper to taste Olive Oil as needed 8 oz Cream Cheese 1 Whole Garlic Bulb top cut off to expose cloves

14 oz Pasta 7 oz Baby Spinach Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Use a 9 x 12 baking dish. Place cleaned sliced mushrooms and onions on the baking sheet. Sprinkle with thyme, salt and pepper. Drizzle with olive oil and toss to coat evenly. Dot cream cheese around the mushrooms and

onions. Place the whole garlic bulb, cut side up, on the baking sheet with veggies. Drizzle the garlic with a bit of olive

Cover the baking dish with aluminum foil. Bake for 30 -40 minutes until garlic is soft and mushrooms and onions are tender. Uncover and place dish under broiler for a few minutes to brown/roast the

garlic. WATCH CLOSE as not to burn. Cook pasta while baking veggies. Ater baking, squeeze roasted garlic and mash them over the veggies. Gradually dd the baby spinach to wilt with the heat while stirring in and cooked pasta with the veggies. Toss everything well to combine.
